Greek Vocabulary For I John

- 1:2 φανερώ – (verb) – I make known, reveal, show, make evident, manifest
 ὄραω – (verb) – I see, observe
 μαρτυρέω – (verb) – I bear witness, testify
 ἀπαγγέλλω – (verb) - I tell, inform; proclaim
 σύ / ὅμοις – (2nd personal pronoun) – sg. – σύ, σοῦ (σου), σοί (σοι), σέ (σε) - you;
 pl. - ὅμοις, ὑμῶν, ὑμῖν, ὑμᾶς – y'all
 αἰώνιος, -ον – (adjective) - eternal (of quality rather than of time); “age-type”
 (the adjective, αἰώνιος, is derived from the Greek noun, αἰών, which means “age, eon”), pertaining to the age to come (i.e., the kingdom of God – hence, “eternal life” is more about “kingdom life” than everlasting life)
 ὅστις, ἣτις, ὅ τι – (pronoun) - who, which; whoever, whichever
 πρὸς – (preposition with accusative) – towards; with
 πατήρ, πατρός, ὁ – (noun) – father
