### Greek Vocabulary for I John 1,2

- 1:10 ἀμαρτάνω – (verb) – I miss the mark, err, make a mistake, sin  
ψεύστης, ψευστου, ὁ - (noun) - a liar; a false, faithless person
- 2:1 τεκνίον, τεκνιου, τό (diminutive of τέκνον) – noun – little child  
μὴ - (particle of negation – [generally used with non-indicative verbs]) - not  
παράκλητος, -ου, ὁ - (noun) - one called to one's side to help
