Vocabulary From 1 John 1:3

ἵνα – (conjunction - most often used to introduce a purpose clause, usually followed by a subjunctive verb [ἵνα + Subj.]) - in order that, that

κοινωνία, -ας, ἡ – (noun) - a sharing in common; a partnership, joint participation; a gift or contribution; a close mutual interactive relationship, fellowship

δέ - (postpositive conj.) – but, rather; **μέν... δέ** - one the one hand... but;

δέ... καί - but... also.

ἡμέτερος, -α, -ον – (first-person plural possessive pronoun) – our

ἔχω – (verb) - I have, hold

μετά - (preposition with genitive) – with

υἱός -οῦ, ὁ - (noun) - son

αὐτός, αὐτή, αὐτό - (pronoun) – he, she, it; self; same

Ἰησοῦς, -ου, ὁ - (noun) – Jesus

Χριστός, -οῦ, ὁ - (noun) – Anointed One; Christ, Messiah
