Vocabulary For I John 1

- 1:8 ἐαυτοῦ, -ῆς, -οῦ - (reflexive pronoun [not used in nominative]) - himself, herself, itself
πλανᾶω – (verb) – I lead astray, mislead, deceive
- 1:9 ὁμολογέω – (verb) – I confess, declare, say plainly
πιστός, -ή, -όν – (adjective) - faithful, trustworthy
δίκαιος, -α, -ον – (adjective) – right, upright, righteous, just, fair, equitable
ἀφίημι- (verb [from ἀπὸ {away from} + ἵημί {I send}]) – I dismiss, divorce, forgive
ἀδικία, -ίας, ἡ - (noun) – injustice, unrighteousness
